Ammunition, such as for rifles, handguns, shotguns, starter's pistols and power tools that contain explosive material are dangerous goods listed under Class 1.4S. The information presented here is for the following UN numbers only:

UN0012 CARTRIDGES FOR WEAPONS, INERT PROJECTILE or CARTRIDGES, SMALL ARMS

UN0014 CARTRIDGES FOR WEAPONS, BLANK or CARTRIDGES, SMALL ARMS, BLANK

UN0055 CASES, CARTRIDGE, EMPTY, WITH PRIMER
