The following statements outline the regulatory compliance of Purolator Inc. regarding the transportation of Dangerous Goods.

Purolator has developed its Dangerous Goods programs to comply with all applicable Canadian and provincial laws and regulations that apply to the services we offer.

Purolator has an extensive Dangerous Goods program, which includes spill prevention, agency notification, appropriate handling, and emergency response to Dangerous Goods incidents. This program is implemented through policies, procedures, practices, manuals, and training. We provide training, as appropriate, for Purolator employees with respect to the safe and secure handling and transportation of Dangerous Goods.

Purolator has appropriate policies and procedures in place that meet the requirements of the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission regarding the transport of radioactive materials.

Where required, Purolator meets and maintains the specific insurance requirements for the handling and transport of Dangerous Goods.

Purolator cannot provide copies of internal policies and procedures to our customers; however Purolator policies and procedures are designed to comply with all applicable laws and regulations.
